Our Giving Trees are up and are ready to be made bare! Take a tag from the tree and go shopping! All gifts need to be returned no later than December 15th. Gift cards need to be returned via the collection basket as indicated on the ornament. Bins will be available at each tree for other gifts. Please place your gift and its ornament inside a bag and then place it in the proper bin marked according to the organization you are helping. Please do not attach the ornament by any means (tying, stapling, taping, etc.) to the bag or the gift. The bag will keep both safe in the bin. Also, do not tie the handles of the bag together. Our Parish Community is known for its compassionate generosity which warms our hearts when we are packing and delivering the gifts we collect. Our time is valuable and deliveries need to be made early enough for the gifts to be distributed to the organizations before Christmas. Attaching the tags or tying the handles means we must undo all the attachments before packing which takes a considerable amount of time.

Pre-Baptism Class

St. Joseph Parish will be holding a Pre-Baptism class for any parent wishing to have their child baptized. The class will take place on **Wednesday, December 11 at 7:00pm in St. Joseph School.**You must register with the parish office before attending the class.

Please call 440-988-2848 to register for the class and to schedule your child's Baptism.

CHOOSING A BAPTISMAL SPONSOR:

<u>Baptism</u>: When choosing a Godparent the following criteria must be met. The sponsor must be Catholic and an active registered member of a Catholic Church, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, and if married, the marriage must be valid in accordance with the Catholic Church. Also, according to the Code of Canon Law, "Only one male or one female sponsor, or one of each sex is to be employed (at Baptism)." (Canon 873)

Additionally, a practicing member of a non-Catholic Christian faith may be included in the Baptism as a Christian Witness, but only together with a Catholic sponsor. A "Christian Witness" is a baptized non-Catholic person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community and together with a Catholic sponsor serves as a witness to Baptism.

<u>Confirmation:</u> When choosing a sponsor the following criteria must be met. The sponsor must be Catholic, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, and if married, the marriage must be valid in accordance with the Catholic Church.

Additionally, the sponsor must be either; 1) a registered active member of either St. Joseph or Nativity Parish OR 2) if registered at another Catholic Church, a sponsor letter must be obtained from that Parish.

Year-End Giving

In the month of December many parishioners very generously make donations before the end of the calendar year. The assumption is that contributions DATED in December are deductible in the current calendar year. However, the deductibility of the contribution is dependent on the date in which the contribution is POSTMARKED or when someone is available to receive it during regular office business hours. Please call the parish office if you have any questions about your contribution. Year-End Statements will be available in mid-January, after we have had time to record all the contributions received in December.

In addition, if you are 70 ½ or older, you may be able to make a gift of a Qualified Charitable Distribution from your IRA that will help us in our ministry and reduce your taxable income. Talk to your advisors and IRA administrator for more information and to be sure that your IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution gift is made directly from an IRA to a qualified charity such as our parish.
