

## **Diocesan-Wide Evening of Confession - March 19**

We bring our sins and struggles to our Lord and to the Church, represented by the person of the priest, when we come to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We confess our sins, our failures and our faults, promise to strive again to conform ourselves to Christ, and are forgiven. "The Lord never tires of forgiving. It is we who tire of asking for forgiveness." (Pope Francis, First Angelus as pope, March 17, 2013)

The Catholic Diocese of Cleveland invites all Catholics to participate in the Evening of Confession this Lenten season on **Wednesday, March 19, 2025**. Many churches across the Diocese will be open for confessions from **5:00 to 8:00 P.M.** on that evening. Father Tim will be hearing confessions at St. Joseph Church on March 19, as well as Thursdays after the 7:00 P.M. Mass and Saturdays from 11:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.

# **REMINDERS FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE**

Fridays during Lent are also days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Likewise, the norms for abstaining from meat are binding from age 14 onward. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection.



The second of the four steps in OCIA for those preparing for the Sacraments of Initiation into the Catholic Faith is called the Rite of Election (or Enrollment of names). This celebration was held last weekend and it closed the period of the catechumenate. In this ancient rite of the Church, the Bishop listens to the testimony of the sponsors, godparents, and assembly. Based upon this testimony, he judges their state of readiness and "elects" or "chooses" them to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at the coming Easter Vigil. 
