mercy to others, just as he did. I ask all the faithful to pray for the peaceful repose of the soul of Pope Francis. May Pope Francis rest in the love and peace of Christ."

Traditionally, the Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be to the Father are recited by all Catholics for the repose of the soul of the Pope. Making a Holy Hour or praying the rosary are also a wonderful ways to pray for and remember Pope Francis. In addition, there are prayer cards and flyers available on the Gathering Area Counter at St. Joseph and on the tables at Nativity.

#### Grief Recovery Program - St. Joseph Parish



If you have been struggling with grief over a loss for an extended period of time—at least one year—please consider participating in the Grief Recovery Program. Grieving is a normal reaction to the losses we face in life. These losses can include death, changes in health or lifestyle, career changes, retirement, and many others.

A recent phenomenon occurred during the Covid pandemic when hospital and nursing home visitations were canceled, and many people died without seeing their loved ones. Funerals were allowed only outdoors. This led to complicated grief. Unresolved grief from any kind of loss can lead to physical health issues, substance use, and depression. This is known as persistent or complicated grief.

This program is based on a 12-step approach to healing. It requires a weekly commitment—up to 12 weeks, a book, and a partner. If you are tired of suffering, please attend an informational session on **May** 7<sup>th</sup> **at 6:30 P.M.** in St. Joseph Social Hall.

### **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY - APRIL 27th**

The Divine Mercy Devotion views mercy as the key element in the plan of God for salvation and emphasizes the belief that it was through mercy that God gave His only Son for the redemption of mankind, after the fall of Adam.

Divine Mercy is a devotion to Jesus Christ associated with the apparitions of Jesus to Saint Faustina Kowalska. In all, there were 14 revelations to Saint Faustina regarding the feast of Divine Mercy. The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her Diary entry 699: My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. To fittingly observe the feast of Mercy, one should:

- 1. Sincerely repent of your sins by attending confession before Divine Mercy Sunday.
- 2. Place your complete trust in Jesus.
- 3. Celebrate Mass and receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast.
- 4. Venerate the Image of the Divine Mercy.
- 5. Be merciful to others through your actions, words, and prayers on their behalf.

#### **Plenary Indulgences - General Conditions**

We confess our sins, our failures and our faults, promise to strive again to conform ourselves to Christ, and are forgiven. "The Lord never tires of forgiving. 


#### Save the Date - VBS is BACK!

The Office of Marriage and Family Ministry is pleased to provide a letter from Bishop Malesic and a certificate for all couples married 50 years. Attendance at the 50th Wedding Anniversary Mass is not required. The certificates and letters are compiled **once a month** and must be requested online in advance.

#### **Cemetery Clean-up**

Our cemetery grounds must be clear for the mowing and trimming season. Any obstructions to mowing or trimming will be removed and discarded. The following is our cemetery policy and it will be adhered to by the groundskeeping crew.

- Decorations, must be removed by April 1<sup>st</sup> for the mowing season. If you want to save your decorations, you must remove them before April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- No plantings of flowers, bushes, or vegetation of any kind are allowed.
- No landscaping or permanent decorations of any kind are allowed, including but not limited to stone, bricks, borders, etc.
- After April 1<sup>st</sup>, only fresh-cut flowers are allowed, in paper or foil wrapping, and these will be removed weekly.
- Regarding holidays during the growing season (April 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>) Decorations will be allowed four days before the holiday. They must be removed 2 days following the holiday. Any decorations you do not remove, will be removed and discarded by groundskeeping personnel.
- Winter decorations will be allowed from October 31st to April 1st.

#### Carlo Acutis - Movie Release



Carlo Acutis: Roadmap to Reality explores the life and legacy of the soon-to-be Saint Carlo Acutis and how he navigated the modern world. It tackles urgent technology-related questions, examining how the virtual landscape threatens our fundamental understanding of what it means to be human.
