



Retreat Leader - Fr. Godfrey Mullen, OSB, is the rector of Cathedral of St. Peter in Belleville, III. Professed as a monk of St. Meinrad Archabbey in 1989. he was ordained a priest in 1994. After returning from studies to the abbey in 2001 and earning his PhD in Liturgical Studies from the Catholic University of America in 2003, he taught seminarians, lay students, and deacon candidates for 12 years. He also held several administrative posts in the seminary at St. Meinrad. In 2012, he became pastor of St. Mary's Parish in Huntingburg, Ind. In 2013, Bishop Charles Thompson assigned him to be rector of St. Benedict Cathedral, and three years ago he began working to develop stewardship as way of life at the cathedral parish. With stewardship as with triving at St. Benedict, he began his new assignment at Cathedral of St. Peter in Belleville, III in 2022.
