STEP 3 - Claim your scholarship tax credit when you file your 2025 State of Ohio taxes.



HOUSE BLESSING FOR THE EPIPHANY

Epiphany (also known as Twelfth Night, Theophany, or Three Kings Day) marks the occasion of a time-honored Christian tradition of "chalking the doors." The formula for the ritual – adapted for 2026 – is simple: take chalk of any color and write the following above the entrance of your home: 20 + C + M + B + 26. The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi – Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar – who came to visit Jesus in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, Christus mansionem benedicat: "May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs represent the cross, and the "20" at the beginning and the "26" at the end mark the year. Taken together, this inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless those homes so marked and that He stay with those who dwell therein throughout the entire year.

The traditional date of Epiphany is January 6, but in the United States, it is celebrated on the Sunday between January 1 and January 8. However, the chalking of the doors can take place at anytime after the Epiphany Mass.

Why not start a new tradition in your family and celebrate the chalking of the doors and invite Christ to walk with you throughout the new year.
