
TUESDAY MASSES

The Angel Scholarship Fund (ASF) is a State of Ohio approved Scholarship Granting Organization.

Donors to ASF may be eligible for a 100% tax credit on their State of Ohio income tax return for the year the contribution is made. ASF donations are awarded as tuition assistance for K-12 students in the Diocese of Cleveland, and donors may designate a school/schools to receive their donation. Just follow these three steps:

STEP 1- Estimate your 2025 Ohio state tax liability

STEP 2 - Make your donation to ASF

STEP 3 - Claim your scholarship tax credit when you file your 2025 State of Ohio taxes.


Monthly Grief Support Groups

Please know that no one from this Parish Office will ask you to make a purchase or respond to an "urgent need." All correspondence from the office will include specific information for the correspondence.

As a best practice, never open any links or give out private information without first checking to see that the source is legitimate.

As a reminder to ensure that you get proper credit on your contribution statement, PLEASE mark the outside of your envelope with the correct amount enclosed.

If you are not using a weekly Sunday Offertory envelope, be sure to include your name and address on your envelope as well. This will ensure that when posting the contributions to your account, we have the correct amount entered.


PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN
