MEMBERSHIP

We Welcome New Members to both our Parish Families! Newcomers are invited to register at either Parish soon after arrival. Registration Forms may be filled out at either office or by phone with one of the staff members. Please advise your Parish Office of any moving plans, change of address, or telephone numbers, email addresses, and/or marital status.

St. Joseph Parish's and Nativity B.V.M. Parish's purpose is to preach the Gospel and minister to the needs of the person within the territory of our parishes. To be an active member of St. Joseph Parish and Nativity B.V.M. Parish is to share in and to be part of parish life. This includes:

- 1) Being registered in St. Joseph Parish or Nativity B.V.M. Parish.
- 2) Faithful participation at Mass on Sunday and Holy Days.
- 3) Supporting your parish in the areas of time, treasure, and talents.

SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM

Baptism: Parents must be active in either St. Joseph Parish or Nativity B.V.M. Parish and attend the required Baptismal Preparation Class in our co-op program with surrounding parishes. The class is offered every month at one of our area churches. Please contact St. Joseph Parish Office to schedule the Baptism and for additional location sites for the classes as they do rotate monthly.

NOTE: A Letter of Eligibility (Sponsor Letter/Certificate) to act as a sponsor for the Sacrament of Baptism and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation can only be issued to registered and participating parishioners. You must be at least 16 years of age and actively practicing in the Catholic Faith. You must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation and if married, the marriage must be valid in accordance with the Catholic Church.

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion: Our Parish School, as well as our Parish School of Religion (PSR) classrooms, use a program called "*Blessed*," to prepare the children (2nd graders) for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Parent participation in the process is required, and all parents are expected to attend the parent sessions for both First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. You are the first teachers of your children's Faith and these sessions are meant to help you teach your child about these very important Sacraments. More information regarding Sacramental formation can be found on our website www.stjosephamherst.com.

Confirmation: Our Confirmation Program involves parental involvement as well as sponsor involvement in order for the Sacrament to have meaning to your child. It is a two-year preparation program for grades 7 and 8 at St. Joseph Parish School as well as for our Parish School of Religion (PSR) students. More information about the program can be found on our website www.stjosephamherst.com.

Marriage: Diocesan policy requires a six-month period of preparation before marriage. Any couple wishing to be married at St. Joseph or Nativity Parish should contact Fr. Tim O'Connor before any date can be finalized. Attendance at one of the pre-marriage preparation programs and a compatibility evaluation are required. Please call the Parish Office for further information.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call for this sacramental anointing before the situation becomes too critical. If you have prearranged surgery and would like to be strengthened by this sacramental anointing of the Church, please call Fr. Tim O'Connor to arrange a time convenient to you (even possibly after one of the Masses).

Hospital Visits: Please notify St. Joseph Parish or Nativity B.V.M. Parish staff to request visitation. Under the HIPAA confidentiality law, hospitals are no longer permitted to notify parishes of a parishioner's admittance.

Holy Orders: Interested in either the; Priesthood, Diaconate, Sisterhood, or Religious Life? Please consider serving the Church as a priest, deacon, religious sister or brother. For more information, contact Fr. Tim O'Connor or you may also visit the Cleveland Diocese Vocations website.
